

***These projects require you to do some research, to see what real trailers, book covers, movie posters, etc. ACTUALLY include. Be sure to look at samples before beginning yours, to ensure that you meet all requirements***

1. Build a 3D miniature stage setting of a scene in the book. This must be VERY detailed, creative, and neat. Include a written/typed explanation of the scene (6-8 detailed sentences minimum).
2. Do a collage with pictures of characters and other aspects of the book. You need to have at least 12 pictures on this collage, and at least half of them MUST be drawn by hand. Pictures must be colored/shaded neatly. The rest can be magazine clippings or printed. Then, write a paragraph (6-8 sentences) to explain what you chose to include on your collage.
3. Create a MOVIE poster. This must be drawn by hand, and should include at least one 3D aspect. Also, your poster should resemble a TRUE movie poster-look at examples. Include a summary of the novel in 6-8 detailed sentences on the back.

OR

Draw one LARGE, DETAILED scene from the book. This must be drawn by hand, and the back of the poster should have a paragraph description of this scene, why it is important to the novel, and why you chose it.

4. Film a movie trailer (minimum of 1 minute in length). The tone of this trailer MUST be serious, and must be original. You cannot include excerpts from the real movie. This should resemble a true movie trailer----watch examples before considering this option.
5. Make a newspaper about the book that includes all of a newspaper's new sections. You should have the main page which includes a major story and headline. In addition to this, you should also have an advertisement, political cartoon, weather/missing ad, and letter to the editor.
6. Make a book cover of the book-design it how YOU would like the cover to look. The inside front flap should include reviews of the book, the back inside flap should include detailed information about the author and a picture, and the back cover should summarize the story IN YOUR OWN WORDS without spoilers. Check to see how long each section is on a real book cover, and make sure that your book cover meets this expectation. The writing should be neat and typed, and the pictures should be colored.
